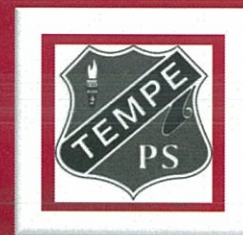

OTHER SCHOOL NEWS

Year 7 entry into selective high schools in 2015

Government schools use a range of strategies to meet the educational needs of gifted and talented students. One strategy is selective high school placement which provides intellectual stimulation and an educationally enriched environment for gifted and talented students.

Offers for selective high school placement will be determined mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 13 March 2014.

To apply for selective high school placement in Year 7 in 2015, you need to do so soon.

Most applicants are expected to apply on the internet and submit their application online. They will need to have an email address (not the student's email address), access to the internet and a printer.

Online applications close on 18 November 2013.

If parents do not have internet access, commercially printed application forms become available from the school on 22 October 2013. They must be completed and returned to the school by 18 November 2013.

UPCOMING CELEBRATIONS & EVENTS

World Diabetes Day – 14 November

The World Health Organisation (WHO) first drew attention to the problem that diabetes poses for world health in 1989. The first World Diabetes Day was proclaimed in 1991 co-sponsored by WHO and the International Diabetes Federation (IDF). These bodies have the responsibility for providing advice to member states on appropriate policies and strategies for monitoring, preventing and controlling diabetes.

International Day of Tolerance – 16 November

The International Day of Tolerance was declared by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) in 1995. This day reminds us to accept and acknowledge difference and uniqueness of every individual.

Universal Children's Day – 20 November

The United Nations General Assembly designated Universal Children's Day in 1953. It is a day when children are honoured by special ceremonies and festivals to make children's needs known to governments. It is observed on different days in different ways in more than 120 countries.

World Television Day – 21 November

In 1966, the United Nations general Assembly proclaimed 21 November as World Television Day. Member states are invited to observe the day by encouraging global exchange of television programs focusing on issues such as peace, economic and social development and the enhancement of cultural exchanges.

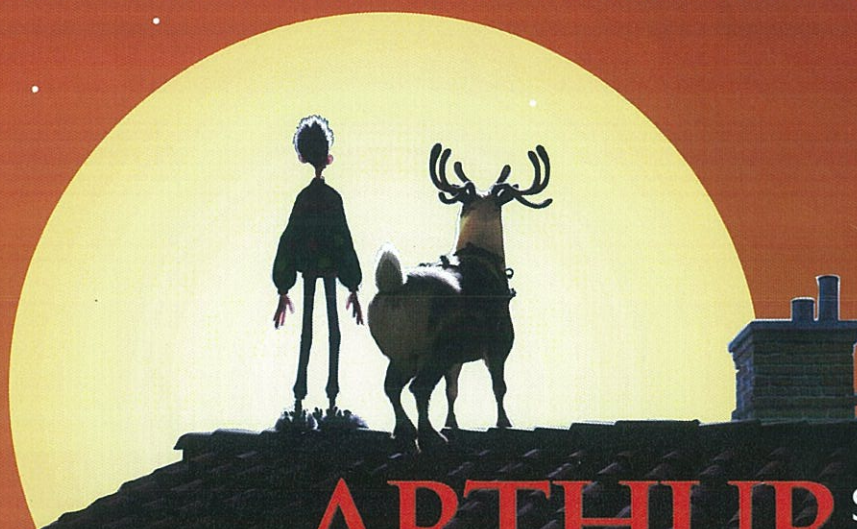

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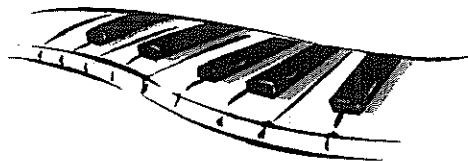
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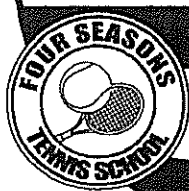
