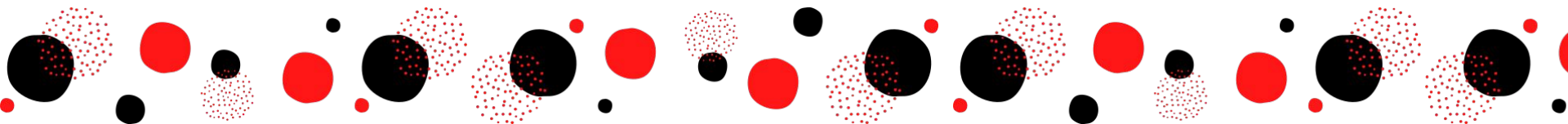

I may not be in my own classroom. Sometimes I will be learning in a different space.





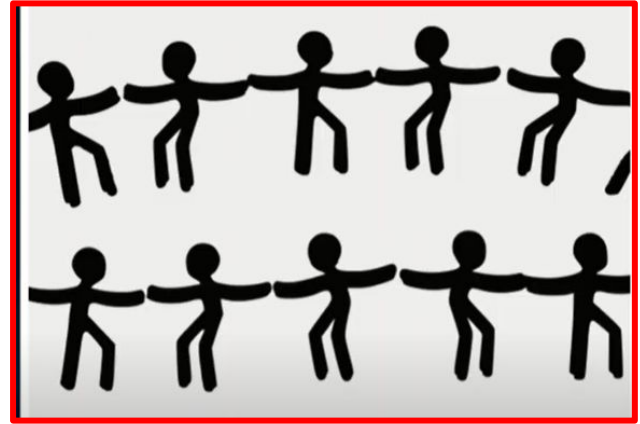
Friends

There will be some changes when I return to school. Some of these changes may include:

My parents and carers will not be able to come onto the school grounds with me. The teachers will be wearing face masks. Stages will have different recess and lunch times.

Monday 18 th October 2021	<p>Morning routine: Kindergarten and Year 1 students are to be dropped off at the front office between 8:35-9:00am.</p> <p>Afternoon routine: Kindergarten and their siblings will be picked up at the front door at 2:45pm. Year One students will be dismissed from the back gate only at 3:00pm.</p>
Monday 25 th October 2021	<p>Morning routine: Kindergarten and Year 1 students will continue to enter through the front doors between 8:35-9:00am. Years 2-6 will enter through the three playground gates which will be open from 8:35am.</p> <p>Afternoon routine: Kindergarten students and their siblings will leave through the front door at 2:45pm. Years 1-6 students will be dismissed from the three playground gates at 3:00pm.</p>

My teacher and friends will be so happy to see me.






Getting Ready for School
