

LEARNING AREAS

ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing: Students will participate in daily independent reading, whole class reading and small group reading tasks. Students will have opportunities to consolidate reading strategies and extend their comprehension skills. Term 1 Stage 2 will be studying the book "The Rabbits", by John Marsden and Shaun Tan.

<u>Writing and Representing:</u> Learning experiences this term will focus on Narrative writing and Procedure texts. Students will learn creative writing techniques and respond imaginatively to a variety of multimodal texts based on the principles of "The Seven Steps For Writing".

Speaking and Listening: Students will practise interaction skills in class and contribute to group discussions about texts.

Spelling, Grammar and Vocabulary: A new grammar and spelling rule will be introduced each week with a variety of engaging activities.

MATHEMATICS

Number and Algebra: Learning in Term 1 will focus on ordering, reading and writing numbers up to and including 5 digits.

<u>Addition and Subtraction:</u> Students will learn and apply appropriate strategies for addition and subtraction involving numbers of 5 digits.

<u>Working Mathematically:</u> Students will practise efficient problem-solving strategies in Number Talks and daily Ninja Maths activities.

<u>Measurement and Geometry:</u> Students will investigate the properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects, including angles. They will select units to measure length, perimeter and area.

Statistics and Probability: Students will investigate chance situations and collect data on their findings.

SCIENCE. TECHNOLOGY AND STEAM

<u>Producing Food and Fibre from Living Things:</u> Students will describe how agricultural processes are used to grow plants and raise animals for food, clothing and shelter.

HISTORY:

<u>Community & Remembrance: First Contacts:</u> Students will describe people, events and actions related to world exploration and its effects.

CREATIVE ARTS

During Semester 1 students will focus on exposure to a range of visual arts techniques with some art pieces relating to the various art forms and media within Australia as well as relating to other learning areas. They will explore the elements of art and provide work samples to support their learning.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Enrichment

This term there will a two-hour session for Enrichment across Stage 2 (refer to the Parent Handbook for more information). Enrichment will begin soon.

Information Technology:

All students will be provided with an opportunity to access technology throughout their learning week. Currently at Tempe Public School we have a class set of laptops that are shared amongst the 4, Stage 2 classes, with each class using 10 laptops within their room at all times. Students will be able to access programs such as Google Classroom, Google, Reading Eggs, Mathletics, Essential Assessment, Typing Tournament and Wingaru.

Homework

Stage 2 students are expected to complete weekly homework activity pages focusing on Numeracy and Literacy skills. Please
encourage your child to select suitable reading material to be read consistently throughout the term.

Scripture & Ethics

- Lessons will continue to be held on Tuesday afternoons.
- Please note that access to Ethics classes is limited, with additional students supervised in non-scripture classes. If you would like to volunteer as an Ethics teacher please contact the school office.

Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) Lessons

- All K-6 students participate in fortnightly PBL lessons about school expectations and routines. This will
 continue to be conducted in class due to the current Covid-19 restrictions of cross stage activities.
